WHEREAS, the Mayor has presented the 2004-2009 Six Year Fiscal Program for the Municipality of Anchorage to the Assembly in accordance with Article XIII, Section 13.02 of the Municipal Charter; and

WHEREAS, a duly advertised public hearing was held prior to adoption in accordance with Article XIII, Section 13.02 of the Municipal Charter; and

WHEREAS, the 2004-2009 Six Year Fiscal Program provides a program for public services, fiscal policies, and capital improvements of the Municipality and presents options for addressing future fiscal requirements; and

WHEREAS, assumptions and projections contained in the Six Year Fiscal Program were developed with information that was considered the most reliable and current at the time; and

WHEREAS, Administration presentation and Assembly approval of the Six Year Fiscal Program does not constitute recommendation or approval of any of the presented alternatives.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:


