A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF ONE HUNDRED NINETY-NINE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$199,600) FROM THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES AS A PASS THROUGH GRANT FROM THE FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION TO THE STATE CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (231) DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES FOR THE AIR QUALITY PUBLIC AWARENESS CAMPAIGN.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the sum of One Hundred Ninety-nine Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$199,600) is hereby appropriated to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231), Department of Health and Human Services, for the Air Quality Public Awareness Campaign.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.

Subject: Resolution No. AR 2003-328, Appropriating Grant Funds from the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities to the Department of Health and Human Services for Air Quality Public Awareness.

The accompanying Assembly Resolution appropriates the sum of One Hundred Ninety-nine Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$199,600) from the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities to the State Categorical Grant Fund (231) for air quality public awareness by the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS). This appropriation funds air quality advertising and outreach to the public, educational and business communities. The bulk of the program budget is allocated for professional services. No matching funds are required. This funding supplements the original grant of \$104,500.
