A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING THIRTY-FOUR THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$34,500) AS A SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH & HUMAN SERVICES TO THE FEDERAL CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (241), DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH & HUMAN SERVICES, TO PROVIDE FAMILY PLANNING SERVICES.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:


Section 1. That the sum of Thirty-four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$34,500) is appropriated as a supplemental grant from the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services to the Federal Categorical Grant Fund (241), Department of Health & Human Services, to provide Family Planning Services.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.

Subject: AR 2003-333, Appropriation of a U.S. Department of Health and Human Services
Supplemental Grant Award for Provision of Family Planning Services

The Municipality of Anchorage has received a supplemental grant award from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services providing an additional Thirty-four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$34,500). The attached Resolution requests appropriation of the additional \$34,500 to the Federal Categorical Grants Fund (241) for the Municipality of Anchorage Family Planning Program. This amendment supplements a previous funding agreement that provides a combined total of \$579,250. The period of the basic grant is from July 1, 2003 to June 30, 2004. Expenditures in this supplemental award are approved from July 1, 2003.

Under the terms of the supplemental grant the Municipal Department of Health & Human Services will purchase contraceptives to insure low-income clients have the ability to plan the timing and spacing of their children and to prevent teen pregnancies. Since January 2003, the costs of various contraceptive products have increased 200 to 600 percent. In an effort to control costs to the Municipality, the variety of contraceptives available in the clinic formulary has been decreased substantially.

The Municipality of Anchorage has been providing family planning services with grant funding since 1969. The focus of the Reproductive Health Clinic is to promote healthy families through planned pregnancies and the elimination of sexually transmitted infections. Services are available for men, women and teens.
