35	Sand Lake El	lementary School is located in	Southwest Anchorag	e at 7500 Jewel Lake				
36	Road. It occupies a 10-acre site with residential housing and a church on the north and							
37	south sides respectively, municipal park land on the west side with vehicular access only							
38	from Jewel Lake Road on the east side. The school was built in 1958 with additions in							

1964 and 1987.

Sand Lake Elementary School provides both traditional and Japanese Immersion programs for kindergarten through 6th grade. The October 31, 2003 enrollment is 635 students, equaling 131 percent of current capacity. Projections through 2008-2009 continue to indicate over current capacity of at least 128 percent. The Revised Design is based on the Districtwide Elementary Educational Specifications for a 26-Classroom Elementary School adopted by the School Board November 2000. With the addition of approximately 4,800 square feet, the building will increase to 60,995 gross square feet and will serve the standard elementary schools capacity of 550 students.

On April 1, 2003 voters approved \$750,000 to fund the design of additions and renovation for Sand Lake Elementary School. Subject to obtaining construction funding in April 2004, construction is scheduled to start in 2005. The project's currently estimated construction cost is \$7,300,000.

All Building Design Committee meetings were attended by members of ASD Facilities Department and members of the Sand Lake Elementary School administration, staff, teachers, and parents. Sand Lake Community Council was invited to particate. A major concern for staff and parents, beyond the current overcrowding, is the ongoing automobile traffic due to parent transportation for the Japanese Immersion program and neighborhood students. Site access is difficult, especially during morning drop-off, with traffic backing up in both directions onto Jewel Lake Road. The proposed design improves the existing situation as much as possible by increasing on-site cueing space. As a further improvement, the Municipality of Anchorage has indicated it will provide a traffic signalization device with the upcoming Strawberry Road Improvements project. Another community concern was that the existing hockey rink be retained. All concerns brought up at these meetings have been addressed in the design, and there are no anticipated negative impacts on the school building or neighboring community.




DSE-EMERY MY JEWEL LAKE ROAD PROPOSED SITE PLAN


