AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 9.06 TO ADD A NEW SECTION ESTABLISHING AN HOURLY RATE FOR POLICE SERVICES DURING AN ACTIVITY OR EVENT HELD IN A MUNICIPAL FACILITY OR RIGHT OF WAY.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

8 <u>Section 1.</u> Anchorage Municipal Code chapter 9.06 is amended to add a new section 9.06.115, establishing an hourly rate for police services as follows (the remainder of the chapter is not affected, and therefore not set out):

9.06.115 Hourly rate for police services.

A. Police services shall be charged at the rate of Ninety-One Dollars (\$91.00) per hour, per police officer, for non-municipal functions, including but not limited to:

Traffic control;

Crowd control;
 Distinguished visitor detail;

4. Activities occurring under municipal permit in municipal right-of-way; or

 5. Any political or non-political events, rallies or gatherings.

B. Requests for police services at any of the types of functions described above shall provide prior written notice as follows:

1. Written requests received more than ten (10) days in advance of the function shall be charged a two (2) hour minimum for each police officer, even if the function is less than two (2) hours in length; or

2. Written requests received ten (10) days or less prior to the function shall be charged a four (4) hour minimum for each police officer, even if the function is less than four (4) hours in length.

C. The number of police officers required shall be in the sole discretion of the Police Chief based upon the type of event, the size of the event including number of participants and vehicles, whether or not alcohol is to be served, whether or not the organization holding the event is non-profit or for-profit entity, complexity of the traffic control plan, if any, adequacy of insurance coverage confirmed by the Risk Manager, the provision of private or volunteer security personnel, or off-duty police officers, and any other circumstances that may compromise the safety, health, and welfare of the participants and municipal citizens.

An Ordinance Amending Anchorage Municipal Code Chapter 9.06 to add a new

section establishing an hourly rate for Police Services during an activity or event held

in a Municipal Facility or Right of Way.

The Anchorage Police Department is requesting the Anchorage Municipal Assembly to amend Anchorage Municipal Code 9.06, Traffic Administration, to add a new section 9.06.115, Hourly Rate for Police Services, to establish an hourly rate for police services.

The Anchorage Police Department has been charging requestors for Police Traffic Control Services at a rate of \$60/hour based on generally assumed authority to bill for services. There was not previously a specific fee authorized in Anchorage Municipal Code. This ordinance codifies the fee for Police Services while updating the rate to be charged based on a current cost recovery model.

The requested ordinance amendment is intended to:

- Establish an hourly rate of Ninety-One Dollars (\$91.00) per hour, per police officer, for non-municipal functions, including but not limited to:
 - o Traffic Control
 - o Crowd Control
 - Distinguished visitor detail
 - Activities occurring under municipal permit in municipal right-of-way
 - o Any political or non-political events, rallies or gatherings
- Establish written notice guidelines for requests for police service as follows:
 - Written requests received more than ten (10) days in advance of the function shall be charged a two (2) hour minimum for each police officer, regardless of function length.
 - Written requests received ten (10) days or less prior to the function shall be charged a four (4) hour minimum for each police officer, regardless of function length.
- Establish the authority of the Police Chief to determine the number of police officers required for an event.

THE ADMINISTRATION RECOMMENDS APPROVAL OF THE ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE 9.06, TRAFFIC ADMINISTRATION.
