The property owner notifies the planning and zoning commission of the abandonment of the conditional use permit. A conditional use shall not be abandoned under this subsection if the result of the abandonment is the creation of a nonconforming land use.

A conditional use granted by the assembly under Section 21.50.160, pertaining to uses involving the sale of alcoholic beverages, shall expire 120 [60] days after the removal of the license to sell alcoholic beverages from the premises, unless there is an application on file with the alcoholic beverage control board to transfer or install a new license on the premises.

AO 2004–6 amends AMC 21.15.030, approval of site plans and conditional uses, to enlarge the time period from 60 to 120 days within which a business currently operating with an approved conditional use permit may apply to the ABC Board for a transfer or a new liquor license before the permit is considered expired. The ordinance is retroactive to October 1, 2003, to establish a window for individuals and entities who have inadvertently missed the 60-day deadline to file with the ABC Board without undergoing a lengthy and expensive process.
