<u>Section 2</u>. That Section 27.30.330 of the Anchorage Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

## 27.30.330 Mountain Park Estates Limited Road Service Area.

- A. There is a limited road service area within the municipality known as the Mountain Park Estates Limited Road Service Area to provide limited road maintenance and repair to the area described on the map located in section 27.30.700.
- B. Limited road maintenance and repair within the service area shall commence on January 1, 1984, and shall end on December 31, 2007 [2004], unless the service area is extended by an affirmative vote of the service area at the regular election of April 2007 [2004]. The mill rate shall not exceed 1.0 mill in any calendar year.

<u>Section 3</u>. Except for Section 2, this ordinance shall become effective upon passage and approval. Section 2 and the proposition contained in Section 1 shall become effective upon certification of the regular election on the proposition called for by this ordinance, but only if that proposition is approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting on the proposition.
