Section 2. That Section 27.30.350 of the Anchorage Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

27.30.350 Raven Woods/Bubbling Brook Limited Road Service Area.

- A. There is a limited road service area within the municipality known as Raven Woods/Bubbling Brook Limited Road Service Area to provide limited road maintenance and repair to the area described on the map located in section 27.30.700.
- B. Limited road service maintenance and repair within the service area shall commence on January 1, 1984, and shall end on December 31, 2007 [2004], unless the service area is extended by an affirmative vote of the service area at the regular election of April 2007 [2004]. The mill rate shall not exceed 1.5 mills in any calendar year except that the mill levy for the tax year 1995 shall be increased to 1.5 mills.
- <u>Section 3</u>. Except for Section 2, this ordinance shall become effective upon passage and approval. Section 2 and the proposition contained in Section 1 shall become effective upon certification of the regular election on the proposition called for by this ordinance, but only if that proposition is approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting on the proposition.
