2 **THE QUALIFIED VOTERS RESIDING IN THE GLEN ALPS SERVICE AREA (GASA) AT**
3 **THE REGULAR ELECTION ON APRIL 6, 2004, A BALLOT PROPOSITION INCREASING**
4 **THE MAXIMUM ATTAINABLE MILL LEVY RATE FOR THE GASA AND AMENDING**
5 **ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 27.30.190 UPON VOTER APPROVAL OF**
6 **THE BALLOT PROPOSITION.**

9 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

11 **Section 1.** That a ballot proposition in substantially the following form shall be submitted to the
12 qualified voters residing in the Glen Alps Service Area at the regular municipal election on April 6,
13 2004.

17 **INCREASE IN THE MAXIMUM ATTAINABLE MILL LEVY RATE**

20 Shall the Glen Alps Service Area (GASA) maximum attainable mill levy rate be
21 increased from 1.5 mills to 2.0 mills, effective January 1, 2004.

26 **Section 2.** That AMC 27.30.190 is hereby amended to read as follows:

27
28 **27.30.190 Glen Alps Service Area.**

30 A. There is established, pursuant to Section 19.09 of the Charter, a service area within
31 the municipality to be the Glen Alps Service Area (GASA) of the municipality, as outlined
32 on the map located in Section 27.30.700.

1 B. All of those services formerly authorized to be performed in the City of Glen Alps
2 under state law and ordinances of the former Greater Anchorage Area Borough may continue
3 to be exercised in the Glen Alps Service Area, provided that services formerly provided, or
4 which could have been provided, in the former City of Glen Alps, may be transferred to new
5 or other service areas where the assembly by ordinance consolidates service areas in which
6 services are provided by the municipality at the same level. The Glen Alps Service Area may
7 also provide for road maintenance/reduction and/or improvements with funds generated from
8 a levy not to exceed 0.5 mill. The maximum attainable mill levy rate shall not exceed 2.0
9 mills.

14 **Section 3.** Section 2 of this ordinance shall become effective upon certification of the
15 regular election held April 6, 2004 if, but only if, the proposition set forth in Section 1 is approved
16 by a majority of the qualified voters voting on the proposition. The remainder of this ordinance shall
17 become effective upon passage and approval.
