Section 2. That AMC 27.30.090 is hereby amended to read as follows:


27.30.090 Eagle River-Chugiak Park and Recreational Service Area.

- A. There is established, pursuant to Section 9.01 of the Charter, a service area within the municipality to be the Eagle River-Chugiak Park and Recreational Service Area (ERCPRSA) of the municipality, as outlined on the map located in Section 27.30.700.
- B. Park and recreational services shall be provided in the Eagle River-Chugiak Park and Recreational Service Area. The mill rate shall not exceed 1.00 [0.50] mill in any calendar year. No more than .50 mill shall be for parks and recreation services and no more than .50 mill shall be for capital improvements.



Subject: **AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A BALLOT PROPOSITION TO SUBMIT TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS WITHIN THE EAGLE RIVER/CHUGIAK PARKS AND RECREATION SERVICE AREA (ERCPRSA) TO ASK THE QUESTION OF INCREASING THE MILL LEVY RATE TO ESTABLISH A CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT BUDGET**

The attached ordinance is being submitted to establish a ballot proposition to ask the voters, within the Eagle River/Chugiak Parks and Recreation Service Area, the question of increasing the mill levy by .50 mills to establish a capital improvement budget fund. This fund would provide the financial support to effectively plan and implement capital construction or major improvements similar to the program successfully implemented by the Chugiak-Birchwood-Eagle River Rural Road Service Area. Recognizing the value of future planning and consistent financial support, an effective, efficient program will be developed through a public process to meet current and future community needs.

The ordinance has been reviewed and endorsed by the ERCPRSA Board of Supervisors and the Eagle River Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors. The Board of Supervisors will provide an annual recommendation to the Assembly on the mill levy the Board wishes to see adopted. This mill levy will provide for service area operations, including capital improvements.
