8                   ORDINANCE NO. AO 2004-37(S)

9                   AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO  
10                  THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF ANCHORAGE, ALASKA, THE  
11                  QUESTION OF THE ISSUANCE OF ONE MILLION TWO  
12                  HUNDRED TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,210,000) OF  
13                  GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF  
14                  ANCHORAGE TO PAY FOR AMBULANCES,  
15                  COMMUNICATION UPGRADES AND RELATED CAPITAL  
16                  IMPROVEMENTS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE  
17                  AT AN ELECTION IN AND FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF  
18                  ANCHORAGE ON APRIL 6, 2004.

19                 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY HEREBY ORDAINS:

20                 Section 1. It is hereby determined to be for a public purpose and in the public  
21                 interest of the Municipality of Anchorage, Alaska (the "Municipality") to incur general  
22                 obligation bonded indebtedness in an amount not to exceed ONE MILLION TWO  
23                 HUNDRED TEN THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$1,210,000) for the purpose of  
24                 paying the costs of ambulances, areawide communication system upgrades and related  
25                 capital improvements within the Municipality.

26                 Section 2. The sum of not to exceed One Million Two hundred Ten Thousand and  
27                 no/00 Dollars (\$1,210,000) shall be borrowed by, for and on behalf of the Municipality for  
28                 the aforesaid ambulances, areawide communication system upgrades and related capital  
improvements, and shall be evidenced by the issuance of general obligation bonds of the  
Municipality. The bond proceeds shall be used only for payment of capital improvements  
and costs of issuance of the bonds. The full faith and credit of the Municipality is pledged  
for the payment of the principal of and interest on the bonds, and ad valorem taxes upon  
all taxable property in the Municipality shall be levied without limitation as to rate or amount

1 to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds when due.

2 Section 3. An election is to be held on April 6, 2004, in and for the Municipality, for  
3 the purpose of submitting a general obligation bond proposition to the qualified voters of  
4 the Municipality for approval or rejection. The proposition must receive an "areawide"  
5 majority vote of those in the Municipality voting on the question to be approved. The  
6 proposition shall be substantially in the following form:

8 AMBULANCES AND AREAWIDE COMMUNICATION SYSTEM UPGRADES  
9 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT BONDS

10 Shall Anchorage borrow up to \$1,210,000 through the  
11 issuance of general obligation bonds to pay for ambulances,  
12 areawide communication system upgrades, and related capital  
13 improvements within Anchorage?

14 Voter approval of this bond proposition authorizes for each  
15 \$100,000 of assessed taxable property value (based on the  
16 estimated total 2004 areawide assessed valuation in  
17 Anchorage) an annual increase in taxes of approximately  
18 \$0.69 to retire the proposed debt.

19 The debt shall be paid from real and personal property taxes  
20 levied and collected areawide within Anchorage. Anchorage  
21 will also pledge its full faith and credit for payment of the  
22 bonds.

24 Section 4. The proposition, both for paper ballots and machine ballots, shall be  
25 printed on a ballot which may set forth other general obligation bond propositions, and the  
26 following words shall be added as appropriate and next to a square provided for marking  
27 the ballot or voting by a machine:


24 Section 5. Section 2 of this Ordinance shall become effective only if the proposition  
25 described in Section 3 is approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting on the  
26 proposition at the general election on April 6, 2004. The remaining sections of this

1 Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and approval.

The attached ordinance AO 2004-37(S) revises the ballot proposition to succinctly describe the essence of the ballot question in one sentence. The introductory question will be used for the Tabulating Ballot required by AMC 28.40.010 (G), which dictates the form of the ballot when optical scanning equipment is used. Specifically, only the title and question will be included on the Tabulating Ballot. The entire proposition will be included on the Explanatory Ballot.
