ORDINANCE NO. AO 2004- 57

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF ANCHORAGE, ALASKA, THE QUESTION OF THE ISSUANCE OF THREE MILLION DOLLARS (\$3,000,000) OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE TO PAY THE COSTS OF ROOF RENOVATIONS/UPGRADES TO THE ALASKA CENTER FOR THE PERFORMING ARTS AND RELATED CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE AT AN ELECTION IN AND FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE ON APRIL 6, 2004.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. It is hereby determined to be for a public purpose and in the public interest of the Municipality of Anchorage, Alaska (the "Municipality") to incur general obligation bonded indebtedness in an amount not to exceed THREE MILLION AND NO/00 DOLLARS (\$3,000,000) for the purpose of paying the costs of roof renovations/upgrades to the Alaska Center for the Performing Arts and related capital improvements within the Municipality.

Section 2. The sum of not to exceed Three Million and no/00 Dollars (\$3,000,000) shall be borrowed by, for and on behalf of the Municipality for the aforesaid roof renovations/upgrades and related capital improvements, and shall be evidenced by the issuance of general obligation bonds of the Municipality. The bond proceeds shall be used only for payment of capital improvements and costs of issuance of the bonds. The full faith and credit of the Municipality is pledged for the payment of the principal of and interest on the bonds, and ad valorem taxes upon all taxable property in the Municipality shall be

1	levied without limitation as to rate or amount to pay the principal of and interest on the				
2	bonds when due.				
3	Section 3. An election is to be held on April 6, 2004, in and for the Municipality, for				
4	the purpose of submitting a general obligation bond proposition to the qualified voters of				
5	the Municipality for approval or rejection. The proposition must receive an areawide				
6	majority vote of those in the Municipality voting on the question to be approved. The				
7	proposition shall be substantially in the following form:

10	Shall Anchorage borrow up to \$3,000,000 through the issuance of general obligation bonds? The bond proceeds would				
11	pay costs of roof renovations/upgrades to the Alaska Center for the Performing Arts and related capital improvements within				
12	Anchorage.				
13	Voter approval of this bond proposition authorizes for each				
14	\$100,000 of assessed taxable property value (based on the estimated total 2004 areawide assessed valuation in Anchor-				
15	age) an annual increase in taxes of approximately \$1.22 to retire the proposed debt.				
16	The debt shall be paid from real and personal property taxes				
17	levied and collected areawide within Anchorage. Anchorage will also pledge its full faith and credit for payment of the bonds.

19	Section 4. The proposition, both for paper ballots and machine ballots, shall be				
20	printed on a ballot which may set forth other general obligation bond propositions, and the				
21	following words shall be added as appropriate and next to a square provided for marking
