AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.30.172 TO CLASSIFY THE EXECUTIVE POSITION OF EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF POLICE AND FIRE RETIREMENT SYSTEM A 23E CLASSIFICATION TO DIRECTOR OF POLICE AND FIRE RETIREMENT A 24E CLASSIFICATION, AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.85.025, AND AS REQUESTED BY THE POLICE AND FIRE RETIREMENT BOARD.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Anchorage Municipal Code subsections 3.30.172E and G are hereby amended to read as follows:
(the remainder of the section is not affected and therefore not set out).

3.30.172 **Classification.**

B. For the purpose of establishing the appropriate compensation for executive classifications, six ranges have been established: 20E (for assembly-appointed classifications), 21E (E-1), 22E (E-2), and 23E (E-3), 24E (E-4) and 25E (E-5). Assignment of a classification to one of the six ranges is based on the appointing authority, level and scope of responsibility for policy development and public advocacy, and particular training and experience necessary to perform the duties.

E. The classifications assigned to range 22E, subject to appointment by the mayor, or by the Anchorage Equal Rights Commission or the Police and Fire Retirement Board subject to the approval of the mayor are:

G. The classification assigned to range 24E, subject to appointment by the mayor, are:



SUBJECT: Ordinance Amending Municipal Code

AMC 3.30.172, Classification, of the Personnel Rules establishes the appropriate compensation for executive classifications. Six ranges have been established. Employee Relations is seeking to amend this section of the Code to incorporate the position of Director of Police and Fire Retirement into range 24E as requested by the Police and Fire Retirement Board and pursuant to Section 3.85 of the Municipal Code.

The ordinance change is clerical in nature and does not affect the salary of the incumbent.
