<u>Section 1.</u> Pursuant to Anchorage Municipal Code subsection 25.30.040B., extension of the lease of the Pioneer School House at less than fair market rate by the Anchorage Woman's Club, a non-profit corporation, for an additional 5-year term expiring on June 30, 2009 at an annual rent of \$600 is approved.

<u>Section 2.</u> Pursuant to Anchorage Municipal Code subsection 25.30.050D., the extension of the lease of the Pioneer School House shall be and is subject to all provisions of Anchorage Municipal Code now in effect.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval.

PIONEER SCHOOL HOUSE, 437 EAST 3RD AVENUE, ANCHORAGE, ALASKA, TO THE ANCHORAGE WOMAN'S CLUB, A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION, AT LESS THAN MARKET VALUE.

In 1915, Jane Mears organized the Anchorage Woman's Club with the goal of establishing a school to serve the families who came north to build the Alaska Railroad. After surviving the earthquake of 1964, Pioneer School House was earmarked for demolition until the Anchorage Woman's Club paid to relocate the building to its present location at 3rd and Eagle Streets.

Since its inception, the Anchorage Woman's Club has contributed to community service projects that enrich the Municipality. Club members promote projects and programs from the arts, conservation, education, home life, international affairs and public affairs. Currently, the Club's major project is raising money to place an automated external defibrillator (AED) in every patrol car of the Anchorage Police Department; this is a \$750,000 project.

Other noteworthy projects include scholarships to high school seniors and women re-entering the workforce, Libraries 2000 and Beyond, Anchorage Literacy Project, a juried art show for high school seniors, Leadership workshops, and U.S. Citizens naturalization ceremonies with voter registration.

The Anchorage Woman's Club seeks to exercise the first of three five-year options under their current The Administration recommends approval of the ordinance extending the lease of the Anchorage Woman's Club an additional 5-year term.
