AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE QUALI-FIED VOTERS OF ANCHORAGE, ALASKA, THE QUESTION OF THE ISSUANCE OF NOT TO EXCEED TWENTY-NINE MILLION SIX HUNDRED THOUSAND AND NO/00 DOLLARS (\$29,600,000) OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE TO PAY THE COSTS OF EDUCATIONAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE AND THE QUESTION OF AN INCREASE IN THE MUNICIPAL TAX CAP LIMITATION TO PAY ASSOCIATED OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE COSTS AT A SPECIAL ELECTION IN AND FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE ON **NOVEMBER 2. 2004.**

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. It is hereby determined to be for a public purpose and in the public interest of the Municipality of Anchorage (the "Municipality") to incur general obligation bonded indebtedness in an amount not to exceed Twenty-Nine Million Six Hundred Thousand and no/00 Dollars (\$29,600,000), for the purpose of paying the costs of designing, acquiring property for, site preparation, constructing, acquiring, renovating, installing and equipping educational capital improvement projects within the Municipality including, but not limited to, the following:

Section 2. The sum of not to exceed Twenty-Nine Million Six Hundred Thousand and no/00 Dollars (\$29,600,000) shall be borrowed by, for and on behalf of the Municipality for the aforesaid educational capital improvements and shall be evidenced by the issuance of general obligation bonds of the Municipality. The bond proceeds shall be used only for capital improvements and costs of issuance of the bonds. The full faith and credit of the Municipality is pledged for the payment of the principal of and interest on the bonds, and ad valorem taxes upon all taxable property in the Municipality shall be levied without limitation as to rate or amount to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds when due.

Section 3. A special election is to be held on November 2, 2004, in and for the Municipality of Anchorage, for the purpose of submitting a general obligation bond proposition to the qualified voters of the Municipality for approval or rejection. The proposition must receive a majority vote of those in the Municipality voting on the question to be approved. The proposition shall be substantially in the following form:

PROPOSITION NO.

EDUCATIONAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT BONDS

Shall Anchorage borrow up to \$29,600,000 through the issuance of general obligation bonds to pay for school construction/design/site acquisitions and related educational capital improvements within Anchorage and increase the municipal tax cap by an amount of \$99,800 to pay for associated annual operations and maintenance costs? \$29,600,000 of the estimated costs of the projects currently qualify for 60% or 70% State debt reimbursement (subject to annual Legislative appropriation as described below).

The general obligation bond proceeds will be used to pay costs of designing, acquiring property for, site preparation, constructing, acquiring, renovating, installing and equipping educational capital improvement projects within Anchorage. The proposed educational capital improvement projects include, but are not limited to, the following:

After completion of the Service High School Phase 2B Construction/Phase 3 Design, the annual operations and maintenances costs are estimated at \$99,800.

PRIVATE SECTOR ECONOMIC EFFECTS:

The estimated annual debt service will be \$2,528,536 which equates to an estimated property tax increase of \$11.88 per \$100,000 of assessed valuation.
