9 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

11 **Section 1.** Anchorage Municipal Code Chapter 12.40, Excise Tax on Cigarettes and Tobacco
12 Products, is hereby amended to add a new section 12.40.022 to read as follows:

14 **12.40.022 Annual dedication.**

16 Each fiscal year, ten percent of the annual gross revenue of the excise tax on cigarettes
17 and tobacco products shall be dedicated to tobacco cessation and education programs as
18 identified by the Municipality of Anchorage Department of Health and Human Services.

20 **Section 2.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by
21 the Assembly.

Subject: Dedication of Excise Tax on Cigarettes and Tobacco Products

At the September 21, 2004, regular Assembly meeting, ordinance serial number AO 2004-131 increasing the tobacco tax was adopted. Proposed AO 2004-146 annually dedicates ten percent of the tax revenue to tobacco cessation and education programs identified by the Department of Health and Human Services. Based on an 8.9 million dollar revenue projection, this equals approximately \$890,000. Dedicating a portion of the revenue to such programs should assist in promoting the public's health and may result in reducing medical and social costs associated with tobacco use.

Accordingly, I urge adoption of ordinance serial number 2004-146.
