ANCHORAGE, ALASKA AO NO. 2004–154

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 11.60 TO ADD A NEW SECTION SETTING THE MUNICIPAL ENTERPRISE SERVICE ASSESSMENT (MESA) CALCULATION FOR MUNICIPAL AIRPORTS.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Anchorage Municipal Code Chapter 11.60 is hereby amended by adding a new section to read as follows:

11.60.205 Municipal enterprise service assessment.

A. An airport shall pay a municipal enterprise service assessment (MESA) for governmental services provided by the municipality, other than those services received by the airport on the airport premises from the municipality on a contract or interfund basis.

B. The MESA for an airport shall be calculated in accordance with section 26.10.025C., except:

1. All leasehold improvements shall be excluded from the airport's adjusted plant in service; and

2. Net contributed plant acquired with Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) funds shall be excluded from the MESA computation.

C. For purposes of this section, and notwithstanding anything in section 26.10.025C. to the contrary, the following terms are defined as follows:

1. Adjusted plant in service shall mean the final, year-end, audited net classified non-contributed plant in service value, less exclusions specified in subsection B. of this section, for the calendar year preceding the mill rate year; for example, in the year 2005, the MESA payment will be based on the 2004 mill rate multiplied by the December 31, 2003 adjusted plant in service.

- 2. Calculation shall mean that the airport's MESA equals the value of the airport's adjusted plant in service multiplied by the annual mill rate (MESA = [adjusted plant in service value x mill rate]).
- 3. *Mill rate* shall mean the aggregate of general property tax mill rates levied against taxable property in the airport's taxing district in the calendar year preceding the MESA payment including all areawide general property tax mill rates and general property tax mill rates levied in service areas within which the airport is located.
- 4. *Net* shall mean plant values which are net of accumulated depreciation and amortization; and
- 5. *Non-contributed* shall mean that portion of a capital improvement funded directly with airport funds.
- D. The airport shall budget annually for the MESA as an operating expense. It is the policy of the municipality that the MESA be considered a part of the airport rate base as it represents a contribution to local government services comparable to that contributed by municipal utilities and private property owners.
- E. To phase in the MESA charge, fifty percent (50%) of the net value of **non-**contributed plant shall be used for MESA calculation purposes for 2005, seventy-five percent (75%) shall be used to calculate for 2006, and the full value of **non-**contributed plant shall be included in the MESA formula beginning in 2007.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.

PUBLIC SECTOR ECONOMIC EFFECTS:

Approval of this ordinance will ensure a more equitable allocation of general government costs to Merrill Field, which has not paid MESA in the past. The ordinance applies methodology to the computation of MESA with respect to contributed capital consistent to that applied to the Port and the Anchorage Parking Authority. It should have no other significant public sector effects.

PRIVATE SECTOR ECONOMIC EFFECTS:

Approval of this ordinance will require a reduction in other airport expenditures, an increase in revenues, or a combination of both, totaling approximately \$52,460 in 2005, \$78,690 in 2006, and \$104,920 in 2007.

AIRPORTS

This ordinance amends Anchorage Municipal Code (AMC) chapter 11.60 to add a new section requiring municipal airports to pay an annual Municipal Enterprise Service Assessment (MESA). MESA is a payment in lieu of taxes (PILOT) for governmental services provided by the municipality, other than those services received on a contract or interfund basis between the enterprise activity and the municipality. Merrill Field is the only municipal airport at present.

 The Port, the Anchorage Parking Authority and all municipally owned utilities are required to make PILOT payments. Currently, the Port of Anchorage pays MESA as described in AMC section 11.50.280. The other Municipal Utilities (Anchorage Water and Wastewater Utility, Municipal Light & Power, and Solid Waste Services) pay for these services as well through a Municipal Utility Service Assessment (MUSA) set out in AMC section 26.10.025, and the Anchorage Parking Authority pays MESA as described in AMC section 9.60.125B.

The value of net non-contributed plant after depreciation, excluding all private leases, is multiplied by the mill rate for all taxing districts that cover the Merrill Field property. Based on current plant figures, the 2005 MESA amount for Merrill Field under this ordinance would be:

\$6,476,543 (projected net non-contributed plant/12/31/03) x 16.20 mills (tax district #1) = \$104,920

However, the ordinance proposes to phase in the total MESA amount over a three-year period to control the impact on Merrill Field's financial condition. So MESA for 2005 will be 50% (\$52,460); 75% for 2006, \$78,690, and 100%, or \$104,920, for 2007. As the mill rate or the amount of net non-contributed plant for those out years changes, so will the MESA computation.

MESA has not previously been collected from the airport. The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) funds approximately 95% of airport capital costs. Congress enacted a prohibition on "revenue diversion" from federally funded airports (49 U.S.C. §47107(b) and (l) (2) (A-D)). A condition of each FAA grant is that all airport revenues must be used for

the capital or operating cost of the airport. Payments in lieu of taxes are not prohibited by 1 2 this law, unless they exceed the value of service provided or are improperly allocated. 3 4 The FAA Policy Statement prohibits: 5 6 Payments in lieu of taxes, or other assessments, that exceed the value of services provided or are not based on a reasonable, transparent cost 7 8 allocation formula calculated consistently for other comparable units or 9 cost centers of government.
