**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 4.60.190  
TO CLARIFY AND EXPAND FUNCTIONS OF THE PUBLIC FACILITIES ADVISORY  
COMMISSION.**

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

**Section 1.** Anchorage Municipal Code section 4.60.190 is amended as follows:

**4.60.190**      **Public Facilities Advisory Commission**

**A.** There is established a public facilities advisory commission consisting of nine persons to advise the mayor and the assembly on policy matters pertaining to management issues related to the following municipally owned/contractor-operated facilities:

- 1.** William A. Egan Civic and Convention Center
- 2.** George M. Sullivan Arena
- 3.** Dempsey Anderson Ice Arena
- 4.** Ben Boeke Ice Arena
- 5.** Other public facilities as the mayor may designate.

**B.** The commission shall:

**1 [A].** At the request of the mayor or his designee, make recommendations for policies on the Egan Convention Center, George Sullivan Arena, Dempsey-Anderson Arena, Ben Boeke Arena, and other public facilities and public leases, to include:

- a.** Reserves for long-term maintenance and replacement;
- b.** Process for site selection of public facilities;
- c.** Policy for private use of public facilities;
- d.** Policy guidelines for disposal or transfer of selected facilities;
- e.** Policy guidelines for leasing vs. owning public facilities;
- f.** Annual appropriations and operation plans;
- g.** Proposed municipal regulations or amendments governing operations and use; and
- h.** Recommendations on public or community issues that affect these facilities.

[UPON REQUEST, ADVISE THE MAYOR AND THE ASSEMBLY  
ON RECOMMENDATIONS FOR ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS ON  
THE PUBLIC FACILITIES INDICATED IN THIS SECTION.]

1        C [B]. Review and, upon request, make recommendations to the mayor on the annual  
2                    operations plans associated with the facilities indicated in this section.

3        D [C]. On request of the mayor or his designee, review and make recommendations on  
4                    proposed municipal regulations or amendments governing operations and use of  
5                    the facilities indicated in this section.

6  
7        E [D]. At the request of the mayor or his designee, review and make recommendations  
8                    on public or community issues that affect the facilities indicated in this section.

3 **Subject:** An Ordinance Amending Anchorage Municipal Code Section 4.60.190 to Clarify and  
4 Expand Function of the Public Facility Advisory Commission

6  
7 The purpose of the proposed code change is to expand the mission of the Public Facilities Advisory  
8 Commission (PFAC) to include a more policy and issue advisory scope regarding public facilities.

9  
10 Specifically, proposed additions to language in the code would be to create a new sub-section B, which  
11 would provide for long-term maintenance and operations, and add policies for site selection, public use  
12 and disposal or transfer of facilities.

13  
14 The Administration is in favor of expanding this role of the PFAC, and the commission also supports  
15 this proposed new role. Both the Mayor and commission agree that this expansion should include more  
16 than the existing facilities in their mission statement: Ben Boeke Ice Arena, William A. Egan Civic and  
17 Convention Center, George M. Sullivan Arena and the Dempsey Anderson Arena.

19 The Administration recommends approval of this ordinance.
