PUBLIC SECTOR ECONOMIC EFFECTS:

The current dollar amount of the child care fines and the system will remain the same. There will be slight fiscal impact due to a possible increase in the number of fines issued a year, from approximately five (5) to a potential of twenty (20).

PRIVATE SECTOR ECONOMIC EFFECTS:

The fines will remain \$75 a day for child care facilities identified operating illegally without a child care license. This code revision will not impact existing child care facilities since they are operating with licenses, unless they open another child care facility without obtaining a license or a child care home expands to become a center without obtaining a center license. It is estimated that 10 to 20 facilities a year will be found operating without the required license. Based on previous history, it is anticipated that corrections will be made after the issuance of only one day's fine.

1 The Department of Health and Human Services, Child and Adult Care Program requests the
2 Anchorage Municipal Code section 14.60.030, Fine Schedule, be amended to adopt fines for
3 child care facility violations as set out in the revisions in the Child Care Code, chapter 16.55,
4 adopted by the Anchorage Assembly on September 8, 2004.

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6 This ordinance repeals fines for violations of a child care center operating without a permit
7 because the child care code revision eliminated the permitting process replacing it with the
8 licensing process. It also amends the code citation in the Fine Table, allowing fines to be issued
9 for child care facilities operating illegally without a license, from AMC section 16.55.300B. to
10 AMC section 16.55.050A., per the code reacted on September 8, 2004.
