A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000) FROM THE KRESGE FOUNDATION TO CAPITAL GRANTS FUND 461 TO FUND COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH PLANNING A GREEN BUILDING AT THE ANCHORAGE MUSEUM OF HISTORY AND ART (\$100,000).

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:
