NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves that:

As part of on-going efforts to prevent and mitigate the danger of a catastrophic disaster and to enhance public safety, the Administration and the Anchorage Fire Department are requested to review, analyze, and make recommendations to the Assembly regarding the implementation of a community-based alert and warning siren system in areas susceptible to these hazards.
