8 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:



10 Section 1. That the sum of One Hundred Ninety-Three Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty-Four Dollars
11 (\$193,964) is appropriated as a grant from the Corporation for National and Community Service to the
12 Federal Categorical Grants Fund (241), Department of Health and Human Services, for enhancing
13 disaster & emergency preparedness of special and vulnerable populations through the mobilization of
14 volunteers.

Subject: AR 2004- 19, Appropriation of the Corporation for National and Community Service Federal Grant Award for enhancing disaster & emergency preparedness of special and vulnerable populations through the mobilization of volunteers.

The Department of Health and Human Services has received a grant award from the Corporation for National and Community Service in the amount of One Hundred Ninety-Three Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty-Four Dollars (\$193,964). This is one of the nation's first federal grants to involve citizen volunteers in homeland security efforts. The period of the grant is from September 1, 2003 to August 31, 2004. Expenditures are approved from September 1, 2003.

The Municipal Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan charges DHHS with addressing the needs of homebound, frail and vulnerable residents in emergency events. Currently, there is no reliable accounting of this population in Anchorage and no formal specific procedures exist to assist these individuals to prepare for or respond to a disaster. To address these needs, the grant funding will allow DHHS to continue working programs started in 2002 to:

- Establish and maintain a comprehensive database of our special needs population;
- Recruit and train volunteers and emergency responders in identifying and serving this population;
- Work with local agencies and groups in designing emergency preparedness activities;
- Coordinate activities with the Anchorage Watchful Alert Ready for Emergency (AWARE) program.

This innovative Anchorage model may be replicated in other cities when completed. This appropriation of \$193,964 is the second year award representing a total funding to date of \$493,964.
