A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE, ALASKA, APPROVING THE EAGLE RIVER AREA HIGH SCHOOL WATER EXTENSIONS AND PROVIDING FOR ASSESSMENT OF BENEFITED PROPERTIES AT TIME OF SERVICE CONNECTION.

WHEREAS, Alaska State Statute 42.05.385 and AMC 19.90 mandate that when a water line extension will create, or has the potential of creating, any charge or assessment against the adjacent property, the water line extension may not be constructed unless the legislative body of each municipality through which the extension passes has approved the extension.

WHEREAS, the Anchorage Water and Wastewater Utility (AWWU) plans to construct a 24-inch water line extension in the Yosemite Drive road easement southwesterly, approximately 2000 linear feet; and a 12-inch water main extension from Yosemite Drive north, approximately 225 linear feet, along the western boundary of Eagle Bluff Subdivision.

WHEREAS, the extension of the water line will specially benefit and provide water service to seven (7) properties previously not benefited, and in doing so will create potential assessments against them.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. It is in the best interest of the community that said water main improvement proceed.

AWWU shall keep an accurate account of all costs of the water main SECTION 2. improvements.

After the water main improvements have been completed and the costs of the water line approved, the Mayor shall cause the computation of all applicable assessment charges.

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<u>SECTION 4.</u> At such time as the property cited on the attached assessment roll connects to the water main, the respective pro-rata assessment for the water line shall be levied in accordance with Municipal Codes and the AWWU Water Utility Tariff in effect at the time.

SECTION 5. A special assessment Collection Charge, as authorized in Rules Section 13.4 and 15.1 of the Water Utility Tariff, in effect at the time the assessment is levied, will be charged to those properties identified in this resolution.

Subject: Approval of the Eagle River Area High School Water Main

Extension and Providing for Assessment of Benefiting Properties

at Time of Service Connection

AMC 19.90 and A.S. 42.05.385 require the Assembly's approval to construct a main extension where the extension will create any charges or assessments against the adjacent properties. A public hearing is required prior to Assembly action.

The Anchorage Water & Wastewater Utility (AWWU), in coordination with the Anchorage School District (ASD) and the State of Alaska, Department of Corrections (DOC), plans to construct a 24-inch water transmission main and a 12-inch distribution water line extension to serve the new Eagle River Area High School and the Highland Correctional Facility. In the effort to serve these facilities and until preliminary platting action of this area is concluded, the water mains will make water service available to seven (7) parcels.

The total water main extension project cost estimate of \$1.19 million will initially be borne by AWWU and ASD. When these newly benefited and previously unassessed parcels connect to the water main, AWWU shall recover a pro-rated share of the costs through the Levy Upon Connection assessment procedures as authorized by the current Municipal Codes and Utility Tariff.

The properties benefiting from the proposed construction are identified on the assessment roll which is made part of the resolution carried by this memorandum. The resolution is also supplemented by a Memorandum of Understanding and Agreement between AWWU, ASD, DOC and the Municipality of Anchorage Heritage Land Bank.

As these properties seek connection, the parcels' pro-rated share of assessable water main costs will be presented to the Assembly for levy confirmation and approval.

The passage of this resolution will have a fiscal impact on seven (7) Municipal owned parcels.



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



