awareness and involvement, and international awareness and involvement; and


WHEREAS, the Alaska Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Sorority, Inc. is

Delta Sigma Theta Sorority International Day of Service HIV/AIDS.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves:
