THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:



Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.

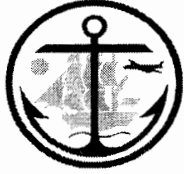

The Administration requests approval of the accompanying Assembly Resolution to appropriate \$17,690 from various community donations for support to the Trail Watch Program. The Anchorage Trail Watch program taps into this community's passion for trails by recruiting trail users to help promote safety and to prevent crime. Volunteers for the program receive safety training, agree to carry cell phones to report suspicious activity, post incident reports on the Trail Watch website and wear distinctive Trail Watch gear. Through this highly visible presence, crime is discouraged and residents feel safer as they use the trails to run, ski, walk their dogs, bike and commute to work. These funds will be used to offset costs associated with the program.
