A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND RATIFYING A TWO AND ONE-HALF YEAR EXTENSION OF THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE AND THE INTERNATIONAL UNION OF OPERATING **ENGINEERS, LOCAL 302.** 

#### THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

WHEREAS, the current collective bargaining agreement between the Municipality of Anchorage (hereinafter "MOA") and the International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 302 (hereinafter "ENGINEERS") expires December 31, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the administration entered into negotiations with the ENGINEERS to "get to zero" in 2004 and forego scheduled pay increases; and

WHEREAS, ENGINEERS and MOA entered into good faith negotiations that resulted in a Contract Extension Agreement which extends the current collective bargaining agreement through July 1, 2008 and established the wages and working conditions for years 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007 and a wage re-opener in 2008 of the bargaining agreement; and

WHEREAS, the members of the ENGINEERS have ratified and approved the Contract Extension negotiated with the Municipality of Anchorage extending the principal collective bargaining agreement until July 1, 2008; and

WHEREAS, Anchorage Municipal Code § 3.70.130 provides for Assembly approval of any negotiated bargaining agreement which has been ratified by the represented employees covered thereunder; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Municipality of Anchorage and the public employees represented by the ENGINEERS that all labor agreements be subject to the public review and approval processed in order to foster good labor-management relationships; and

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends approval of this negotiated Contract Extension Agreement as set forth in the Assembly Memorandum attached hereto;

AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE AND

THE INTERNATIONAL UNION OF OPERATING ENGINEERS, LOCAL

302.

The Municipality of Anchorage (MOA) has reached agreement on a two and one-half (2 ½) year extension to the collective bargaining agreement (CBA) with the International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 302 (Engineers). On March 16, 2004, the Engineers agreed to extend the CBA until July 1, 2008. In cooperation with Administration and Mayor Begich's initiative to "get to zero" in 2004, the Engineer's gave up a two percent wage increase. The contract introduced an apprenticeship program and added a personal holiday. When compared to the base cost for the bargaining unit, the overall additional cost of the three (3) year CBA for General Government is \$2,098,980. The overall additional cost to SWS for the three (3) year CBA is \$1,265,000. The Administration recommends Assembly approval of the negotiated CBA.

## Highlights of the Engineers' CBA:

Agrees to zero wage increase in 2004 foregoing a 2% wage increase

- Agrees to a 4% increase in wages May 1, 2005, 3 % increase in wages effective January 1, 2006 and 2.9% increase in wages effective January 1, 2007.

- Parties agree to extend the terms and conditions of the MOA/L-302 CBA from December 31, 2005 through July 1, 2008.

THE ADMINISTRATION RESPECTFULLY RECOMMENDS THE ASSEMBLY APPROVE THE TWO (2) YEAR EXTENSION OF THE CBA BETWEEN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE AND THE INTERNATIONAL UNION OF OPERATING ENGINEERS, LOCAL 302.
