
1 A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH THE DELINQUENT DATES FOR THE FIRST AND

5 The Anchorage Assembly hereby resolves:


6 Section 1. Payment for the first half of annual business personal and personal property
7 taxes is due on August 31, 2004 and will become delinquent on September 1, 2004 and payment for
8 the second half of annual business personal and personal property taxes is due on October 31, 2004
9 and will become delinquent on November 1, 2004.

10 Section 2. This resolution shall be effective on the day of approval by the Anchorage
11 Assembly.

3 **Subject:** Due Dates for Payment of 2004 Business Personal and Personal Property
4 Taxes

6 Section 29.45.240 (a) of the Alaska Statutes states in part, "The rate of levy, the date of
7 equalization, and the date when taxes become delinquent shall be fixed by resolution." AMC
8 12.15.060 A.1 provides that "Any installment shall become delinquent on the first business day
9 following the tax installment due date."

10
11 The Municipal Code grants a seven-day grace period after the tax due date before any penalty is
12 added to the tax. Tax bills are mailed to owners of record 30 days prior to the due date.

13
14 AR NO. 2004- 144 establishes the due dates for payment of first and second installments for the
15 2004 business personal and personal property taxes as August 31, 2004 and October 31, 2004,
16 respectively, and the delinquent dates as September 1, 2004 and November 1, 2004 respectively.

18 The Administration recommends approval of AR No. 2004- 144 .
