Due Dates for Payment of 2004 Business Personal and Personal Property

Taxes

Section 29.45.240 (a) of the Alaska Statutes states in part, "The rate of levy, the date of equalization, and the date when taxes become delinquent shall be fixed by resolution." AMC 12.15.060 A.1 provides that "Any installment shall become delinquent on the first business day following the tax installment due date."

The Municipal Code grants a seven-day grace period after the tax due date before any penalty is added to the tax. Tax bills are mailed to owners of record 30 days prior to the due date.

AR NO. 2004-144 establishes the due dates for payment of first and second installments for the 2004 business personal and personal property taxes as August 31, 2004 and October 31, 2004, respectively, and the delinquent dates as September 1, 2004 and November 1, 2004 respectively.

The Administration recommends approval of AR No. 2004-144.
