**A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY STATING ITS
TEMPORARY NON-OBJECTION TO A NEW BEVERAGE DISPENSARY/TOURISM AND
RESTAURANT DESIGNATION LIQUOR LICENSE FOR HOST INTERNATIONAL INC.
D.B.A. CHILI'S TOO #4403 LOCATED AT ANCHORAGE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT
(TED STEVENS INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT)**

WHEREAS, Host International Inc. D.B.A. Chili's Too #4403 has applied for a new beverage/tourism and restaurant liquor license and has filed application with the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board; and

WHEREAS, Chili's Too #4403 desires to open its business prior to inspection by the Anchorage Fire Department projected to be June 22, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly is willing to temporarily non-protest the license subject to the conditions stated below.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves that:

Section 1: This body does not protest the new beverage dispensary/tourism liquor license to Chili's Too #4403 located at the Anchorage International Airport (Ted Stevens International Airport).

Section 2: This temporary non-objection is not intended to bind the Assembly to a future non-objection of this license.


Section 3: A copy of this resolution may be presented to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board as proof that the Anchorage Assembly, as the local governing body, has temporary non-protested the new license in order to permit the Director of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board to issue temporary approval of the license.

Section 4: This resolution is subject to the terms of the required conditional use of this location.
