With the required Municipal match of \$43,743, the 10 total grant program was \$437,429. This grant was used to fund the Sexual Assault Response Team 11 12 (DHHS) and police equipment purchases for enhanced records management technology. 13 14 One of the conditions of this grant was that all federal funding be placed in an interest bearing account and the accrued interest must be used for police programs and activities.
