The accompanying Assembly Resolution appropriates Four Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-Seven Dollars (\$478,927) from the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT & PF) to State Categorical Grant Fund (231) for a Block Heater Installation Program by the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS). A transfer of responsibilities agreement was executed between the Municipality and ADOT & PF on June 23, 2004 and is valid through December 31, 2005. This appropriation will fund block heater installations in private vehicles this winter and a portion of next. No matching funds are required.

Over the past two winters the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation contracted with two private garages to install engine block heaters in Anchorage vehicles. Approximately 3,500 block heaters were installed at a cost of \$25 to participants. The actual cost for each installation averaged approximately \$160. The cost difference was paid by Congestion Mitigation - Air Quality grant funds from the Federal Highway Administration, passed through ADOT & PF.

DHHS has agreed to take over administration of this federally-funded program in order to increase the use of block heaters to reduce carbon monoxide (CO) pollution. Studies in Anchorage and Fairbanks have shown that use of block heaters for two to three hours before starting reduces cold start emissions about 60%. Most funds will go to garages contracted to perform installations and for equipment to facilitate plugging in, such as timers and extension cords.
