
1 A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF

9 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:



**Subject:** AR 2004- 226 , Appropriating Grant Funds from the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities for Air Quality Public and Business Awareness Education Campaign by the Department of Health and Human Services

The accompanying Assembly Resolution appropriates Three Hundred Thirty-Five Thousand Two Hundred Forty-Nine Dollars (\$335,249) from the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities to State Categorical Grant Fund (231) for the Air Quality Public and Business Awareness Education Campaign by the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS). This appropriation funds air quality education and outreach from July 7, 2004 through December 31, 2005. This appropriation will provide the funding necessary to continue air quality education and outreach to Anchorage motorists in the public and business communities. No matching funds are required.

The Department of Health and Human Services has conducted air quality advertising to the Anchorage driving public for six years to encourage the use of engine block heaters, alternative transportation and measures to reduce carbon monoxide and air toxics emissions from personal vehicles. Surveys have shown the effectiveness of these programs, especially in neighborhoods with many cars parked outdoors overnight. Most funds for this winter campaign will go for professional advertising services and an education and outreach program targeted to commuters in the business community.
