Under the terms of the grant the Municipal Department of Health and Human Services will:

- Provide clinical reproductive health services for low income women, men and teens;
- Work in partnerships with other groups and agencies that work with similar priority populations, including low income women and high risk, runaway youth;
- Provide pregnancy testing and referral;
- Increase emphasis on services to adolescents, including emphasis on postponement of sexual activity
  and more accessible provision of contraceptive counseling and services through use of Teen Peer
  Health Educators. Increase emphasis on reaching minority and ethnic youth groups;
- Increase services to hard-to-reach populations by partnering with community-based organizations and others that have a stake in the prevention of unintended pregnancies;
- Provide comprehensive reproductive health services to include necessary lab tests for anemia, pregnancy, sexually transmitted infections, cervical cancer; screening for breast and testicular cancer; and education and counseling in the selection and use of a contraceptive method;
- Increase services to males, emphasizing shared responsibility for preventing unintended pregnancy and sexually transmitted infections;
- Maintain statistical data as required under Title X;
- Maintain documentation and records within the requirements of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) which are readily accessible for fiscal review; and
- Provide reports as required by federal regulations.

The Municipality of Anchorage has provided family planning services with grant funding since 1969. The focus of the program is to provide low income women and men the ability to plan the timing and spacing of their children and to prevent teen pregnancies.

During calendar year 2003, the clinic provided 11,707 visits. The 2003 Family Planning Annual Report indicated 6,882 unduplicated clients; 4,706 women and 2,176 men received services. 85% of the clients had incomes at or below 150% poverty, according to Federal Poverty Guidelines, and 91% had incomes that qualified them for reduced or no payment on a sliding fee scale.
