The State of Alaska Department of Transportation & Public Facilities (ADOT&PF) has made an offer to the Municipality to purchase certain portions of Lots 2 and 3, Section 18, Township 12 North, Range 3 West, to facilitate ADOT&PF's C Street Improvement Project. The C Street project will be a four-lane divided corridor from Dimond Boulevard to O'Mallev Road with a grade-separated interchange at O'Malley Road. O'Malley Road will pass over the extension of C Street. There will be intersections at 92nd Avenue and 100th Avenue. A pathway/sidewalk will be constructed on both sides of C Street. Construction is anticipated to commence in the summer of 2004. ADOT&PF requires a fee simple interest area and two temporary construction permits on Lot 2 and a fee simple interest area on Lot 3. These areas are shown in detail on the attached exhibits.

In 1996, the Municipality purchased Lot 2 and the east 40 feet of Lot 3 from Wallace Martens for development of the 97th Avenue Snow Disposal Site and Sedimentation Basin. Lot 2 contains the snow disposal site and sedimentation pond. The east 40 feet of Lot 3 was purchased to guarantee legal access to Lot 2. The Municipality chose to rent an existing gravel road that crosses the Martens property to access the snow disposal site, rather than build a new road due to poor soil conditions and the high cost of construction of a new road.

32 33 ADOT&PF and the Municipality have reached an administrative settlement of \$2.85/s.f. based upon the Municipality's investment in Lot 2 and ADOT&PF's fee appraisal offer that reflects current market value. Lot 3 is an uneconomic remnant that is valued at the Municipality's original purchase price of \$1.00/s.f. The temporary construction permit area value is based on the calculation of \$2.85/s.f. x 10% x 2-year rental x the square footage of use. The following is a summary of values:
