21 THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:


23 Section 1. That the sum of ONE HUNDRED TWENTY EIGHT THOUSAND
24 ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY FIVE DOLLARS (\$128,175), is appropriated from the U.S.
25 Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Local Law Enforcement Block Grant
26 (LLEBG) Program to the Federal Categorical Grants Fund (241), Anchorage Police Department
27 for the purpose of underwriting projects to reduce crime and improve public safety.

29 Section 2. That the sum of TWENTY ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
30 SIXTY TWO DOLLARS (\$21,862) is appropriated as a match from the Anchorage Metropolitan
31 Police Service Area Fund (151) to the Federal Categorical Grant Fund (241) for the purpose of
32 underwriting projects to reduce crime and improve public safety.

Subject: Appropriation from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs for a Local Law Enforcement Block Grant (LLEBG) Award 2004-LB-BX-0190 (\$150,037)

Local Law Enforcement Block Grants, authorized by the Omnibus Consolidated and Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act, 1999 Public Law 105-277, provide local governments with funds to underwrite projects to reduce crime and improve public safety. The Municipality of Anchorage has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$128,175 with a required local match of \$21,862 for a total program budget of \$150,037. These amounts are requested to be appropriated to the Federal Categorical Grants Fund (241) for use by the Anchorage Police Department. The term of this grant is 24 months from the date drawn by the Municipality.

The Grant Advisory Board met on September 7, 2004 and recommended the use of funding as follows:
