Justice Assistance to fund the Sexual Assault Response Team (SART) program.

The attached Assembly Resolution appropriates One Million Nine Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty-Five Dollars (\$1,978,955) to fund the Sexual Assault Response Team (SART) Program within the Department of Health and Human Services. The period of the grant is from October 1, 2004 to September 30, 2007.

 The Sexual Assault Response Team has provided a coordinated and multidisciplinary approach to victims of sexual assault since June 1, 2003. The team is composed of representatives from law enforcement (Anchorage Police Department), sexual assault victim advocacy programs (Standing Together Against Rape) and forensic nurse examiners (Department of Health & Human Services). The purpose of the team is to efficiently and collaboratively meet the medical and emotional needs of victims of sexual assault, as well as to meet the evidentiary prosecutorial needs of the criminal justice system. Through coordination of the investigation process, the SART program seeks to reduce repeated questioning for the victim and to increase effective collection and preservation of evidence.

The SART program is intended to:

- Improve the sensitivity of the investigation and quality of care for the victim.
- Improve the quality of the investigation and forensic evidence.
- Increase the conviction rate of sexual assault perpetrators.
- Work in partnerships with other groups and agencies that work with similar priority populations.
- Maintain statistical data.
- Maintain documentation and records which are readily accessible for fiscal review.
- Provide reports as required by federal regulations.
