1 A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE ACCEPTING AND
2 APPROPRIATING ONE MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED FORTY THOUSAND DOLLARS
3 (\$1,740,000) AS A GRANT FROM THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND
4 GAME, TO THE ANCHORAGE ROADS AND DRAINAGE SERVICE AREA FUND
5 (441), FOR THE SHIP CREEK CROSSING PROJECT.

9 WHEREAS, the culverts crossing Ship Creek, installed in the early 1970's,
10 are in imminent danger of failing, which would have serious environmental impacts on
11 the area's natural resources; and

13 WHEREAS, partial funding for the Ship Creek crossing project is being
14 provided through National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration grants; and
15

16 WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage has received a grant in the
17 amount of \$1,740,000 from the Alaska Department of Fish and Game to construct a
18 new Ship Creek crossing; and

20 WHEREAS, the Municipality has relocated utilities that were buried over
21 the existing culverts; and

23 WHEREAS, the Municipality has obtained the necessary permits to allow
24 for the removal of the culverts and the construction of a new crossing; now therefore,

26 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

28 **Section 1.** That a sum of One Million Seven Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars
29 (\$1,740,000) in grant monies from the Alaska Department of Fish and Game be
30 appropriated for construction activities related to a new Ship Creek crossing.

32 **Section 2.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and
33 approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.

SUBJECT: Resolution to Accept and Appropriate Alaska Department of Fish and Game
Grant Funds for the Ship Creek Crossing Project, Project No. 02-01
(\$1,740,000)

The Alaska Department of Fish and Game has granted the Municipality \$1,740,000 for the construction of the new Ship Creek crossing. There is an imminent failure situation within the existing crossing of Ship Creek on the Ship Creek Point Access Road. The road crossing is supported by three arch culverts which are corroding and collapsing. This road provides the only access to Ship Creek Point and is well-traveled by local sport fishermen, boat storage users and launch area users. Water utility and natural gas lines within the project have already been relocated.

The existing crossing has been determined to have the following deficiencies, according to the *Ship Creek Culvert Removal Project Environmental Assessment* (HDR, Inc., 2002):

- The embankment crossing Ship Creek has substantially degraded, threatening the integrity of the road and the ecosystems of Ship Creek and Upper Cook Inlet.
- The existing three-arch culverts are corroding and collapsing, affecting fish passage.
- Much of the original three-foot-thick layer of riprap has fallen from the face of the embankment on both the upstream and downstream sides of the crossing, also affecting fish passage.

This grant will supplement the cost of work and materials required to remove the existing culverts and construct a new bridge crossing Ship Creek. The accounting detail is as follows:

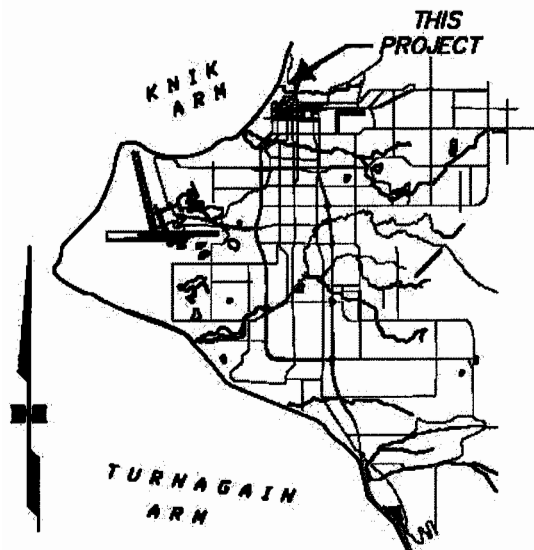
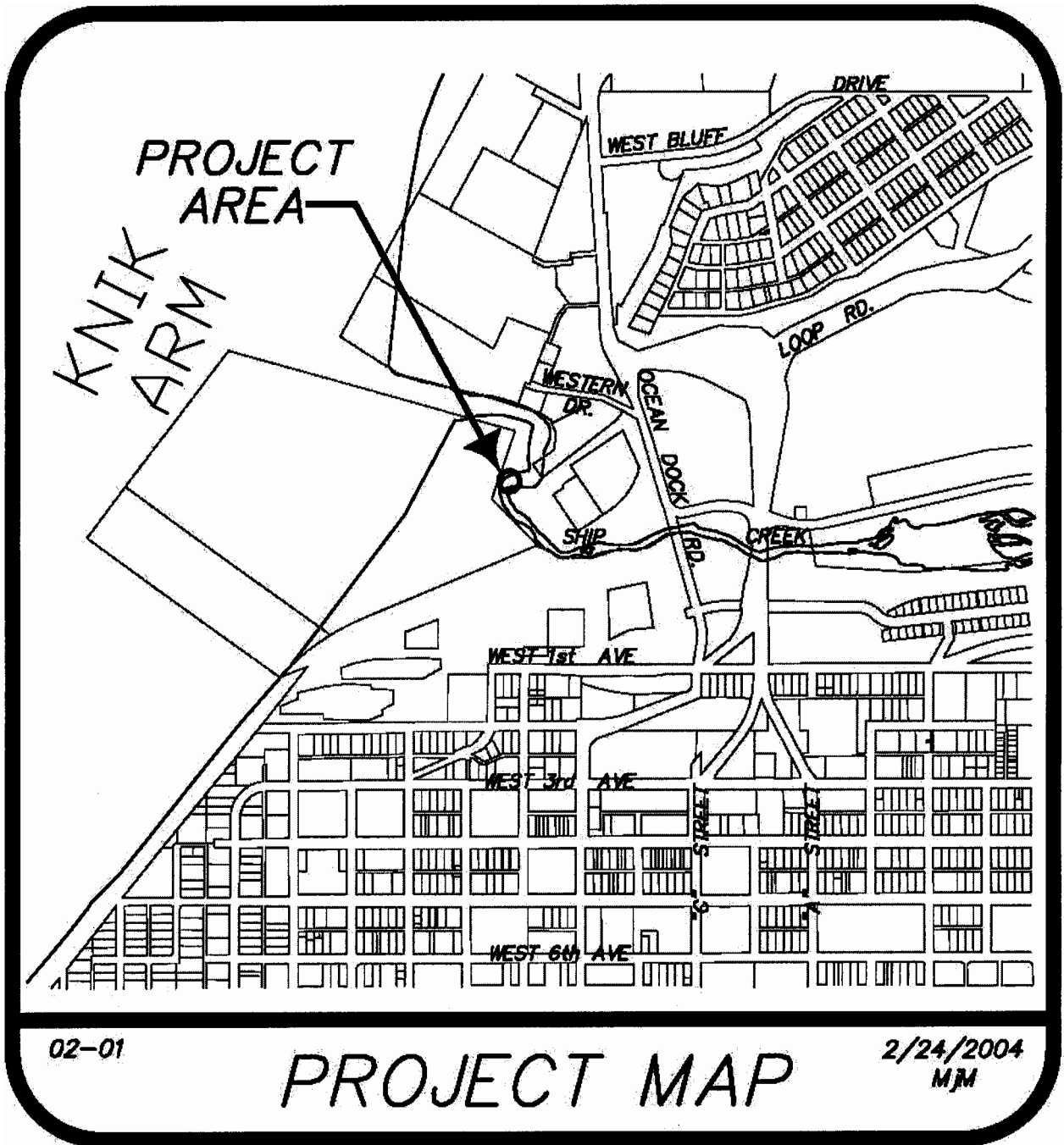
