1 A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN ALTERNATIVE ALLOCATION METHOD FOR THE FY05
2 SHARED FISHERIES BUSINESS TAX PROGRAM AND CERTIFYING THAT THIS ALLOCATION
3 METHOD FAIRLY REPRESENTS THE DISTRIBUTION OF SIGNIFICANT EFFECTS OF
4 FISHERIES BUSINESS ACTIVITY IN THE COOK INLET FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AREA

6 WHEREAS, AS 29.60.450 requires that for a municipality to participate in the FY 05
7 Shared Fisheries Business Tax Program, the municipality must demonstrate to the Department of
8 Community and Economic Development that the municipality suffered significant effects during
9 calendar year 2003 from fisheries business activities; and,

11 WHEREAS, 3 AAC 134.060 provides for the allocation of available program funding
12 to eligible municipalities located within fisheries management areas specified by the Department of
13 Community and Economic Development; and,



15 WHEREAS, 3 AAC 134.070 provides for the use, at the discretion of the
16 Department of Community and Economic Development, of alternative allocation methods which
17 may be used within fisheries management areas if all eligible municipalities within the area agree
18 to use the method, and the method incorporates some measure of the relative significant effect of
19 fisheries business activity on the respective municipalities in the area; and,

21 WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage proposes to join all other participating
22 municipalities within the Cook Inlet Fisheries Management Area in an alternative allocation method
23 for FY05; and,

25 WHEREAS, such alternative allocation shall be fifty percent (50%) divided equally
26 and fifty percent (50%) divided on a per capita basis;

28 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, The Anchorage Assembly by this
29 resolution certifies that the alternative allocation method fairly represents the distribution of
30 significant effects during 2003 of fisheries business activity in the Cook Inlet Fisheries
31 Management Area.

SUBJECT: FY 05 Shared Fisheries Business Tax Program

The Shared Fisheries Business Tax Program was created by the Legislature in 1991. The purpose of this program is to provide for a sharing of state fish tax collected outside municipal boundaries with municipalities that have been affected by fishing industry activities. Municipalities around the State will share approximately \$1.72 million based on 2003 fisheries activity as reported by fish processors on their fish tax returns.

Anchorage is located in the Cook Inlet Fisheries Management Area. Other municipalities located in this area are Homer, Kenai Peninsula Borough, Kachemak, Seldovia, Seward and Soldotna. The FY 05 program total allocation to be shared within this area is approximately \$56,542.39. Anchorage's share is estimated to be \$25,999.84. The alternative allocation methodology is: 50% divided equally between all the municipalities applying and 50% divided on a per capita basis.

To participate in this program, the municipal governing body is required to approve a resolution requesting funding using the alternative allocation method.

THE ADMINISTRATION RECOMMENDS APPROVAL OF THIS RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE ALTERNATIVE ALLOCATION METHOD AND REQUESTING FISHERIES TAX REVENUES FOR 2005.
