WHEREAS, subject to annual appropriation of funds by the Anchorage Assembly, the Department of the Army has agreed to lease approximately 7.302 acres of land to the Port of Anchorage for the Port's expansion project development of road and rail access which will require the use of funds not included in the 2004 Approved Port of Anchorage Operating Budget; now therefore,

#### THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. The Port of Anchorage is authorized to enter into a 25 year lease for 7.302 acres of U.S. Department of the Army property, based upon the terms set out in the Assembly Memorandum accompanying this resolution.

Section 2. The sum of One Hundred Nineteen Thousand Two Hundred Forty-Six Dollars (\$119,246) is hereby appropriated to the Port of Anchorage Operating Fund (570).

**Section 3.** The Approved 2004 Port of Anchorage Operating Budget is hereby revised as follows:

**Section 4.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Assembly.

OPERATING BUDGET.

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The first phase of the Port of Anchorage's expansion program entails construction of road and rail access along the Port's East boundary, which is encompassed by Fort Richardson and owned by the Department of the Army.

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The Port of Anchorage obtained an appraisal from Blacksmith & Richards on April 2, 2004, updated on May 7, 2004, concluding the fair market rental value of the property to be \$0.375 per square foot (for 317,988 square feet, or 7.302 acres). Based on the appraisal, the Port of Anchorage and the Department of the Army negotiated a twenty-five (25) year lease of the property, paid annually at market rate for One Hundred Nineteen Thousand Two Hundred Forty-Five and Fifty Cents (\$119,245.50). Additional lease terms are as follows:


