A MEMORANDUM REQUESTING APPROVAL OF PAY INCREASES FOR THE NON-REPRESENTED EMPLOYEES. THE INCREASES WILL MIRROR THE ASSEMBLY APPROVED COLLECTIVE BARGAINING

AGREEMENT PATTERNS.

In order to reflect equity amongst the Municipality of Anchorage (MOA) workforce for 2005 through 2007, the Mayor has proposed pay increases for non-represented employees. The increases mirror the same pattern used in recently approved collective bargaining contracts. Since many of nonrepresented employees are supervisors of unionized employees, and since these increases reflect the same pattern used in collective bargaining, these increases will ensure equity and fairness in the pay patterns. The non-represented pattern increases have already been incorporated into the 2005 budget and approved by the Assembly.

Highlights of the pay increases:

- Non-Represented employees received no pay increases in 2004,
- A 3.3% increase in the first full pay period of January, 2005,
- A 3.3% increase in the first full pay period of January, 2006,
- A 3.4% increase in the first full pay period of January, 2007.

THE ADMINISTRATION RESPECTFULLY RECOMMENDS THE ASSEMBLY APPROVE THE PAY INCREASES FOR NON REPRESENTED EMPLOYEES OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE.
