

Appropriating Congressional Earmark Funds for the Department of Health and Human Services

for Anchorage Air Program Initiatives.

The accompanying Assembly Resolution appropriates One Million Nine Hundred Eighty-Eight Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$1,988,100) from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to the Federal Categorical Grants Fund (241), Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS). Through the efforts of Senator Ted Stevens, this funding was included in the FY 2004 Consolidated Appropriations Bill and is being administered by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). The EPA has approved a work plan prepared by the DHHS for five air quality projects to be implemented over the course of the next four years. The grant covers the period September 1, 2004 through December 31, 2008. No local match funding is required.

 Because the EPA is administering this funding through Section 103 of the Clean Air Act, there are some restrictions on how funds can be spent. Section 103 funding is generally restricted to research investigations, air pollution monitoring and the dissemination of air quality data to the public. The five projects outlined by DHHS and approved by the EPA are consistent with Section 103 requirements. These projects include: (1) a new Internet-based air quality monitoring network that will allow the public to access monitoring data on a "real-time" basis 24 hours per day, 7 days per week; (2) an assessment of current PM-10 (dust) control strategies and implementation of new, improved methods to control dust; (3) an indoor air quality project designed to reduce exposure to benzene and other toxic air pollutants in Anchorage homes; (4) pollen counting and reporting in the spring, summer and fall through 2008; and (5) visibility monitoring to establish a historical range of visibility conditions and document events such as dust storms, volcanic eruptions and wild fire smoke that widely impact Anchorage air quality.
