## ANCHORAGE, ALASKA AO NO. 2005–38(S-1)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 15.75 REGARDING PESTICIDE CONTROL TO MODIFY DRIFT PROTECTION AND PUBLIC NOTICE FOR COMMERCIAL PESTICIDE APPLICATION AND APPLICATION BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE.

## THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

**Section 1.** Anchorage Municipal Code section 15.75.050 is hereby amended to read as follows:

15.75.050 Commercial application prohibited during certain [WIND] conditions.

A person who engages in the business of applying pesticides or broadcast chemicals may not apply by spraying any pesticide or broadcast chemicals out of doors if the wind speed exceeds <u>5.75 miles per hour</u> [FIVE KNOTS] at the site of application. A person may not apply a pesticide in a manner that results in pesticide drift.

**Section 2.** Anchorage Municipal Code section 15.75.065 is hereby amended to read as follows: (Other subsections not affected are not set out.)

## 15.75.065 Notice of application by municipality.

B. Notice must be given at least 48 hours before application and not more than 120 [96] hours before application. Posted notices shall be situated as to remain in place for at least 48 hours following pesticide or broadcast chemical application.
