## ANCHORAGE, ALASKA AO NO. 2005 – 38(S-2)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 15.75 REGARDING PESTICIDE CONTROL TO MODIFY DRIFT PROTECTION AND PUBLIC NOTICE FOR COMMERCIAL PESTICIDE APPLICATION AND APPLICATION BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE

### THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Anchorage Municipal Code section 15.75.020 is hereby amended by adding certain definitions to read as follows (other definitions in the section are not affected and therefore not set out):

### **15.75.020 Definitions.**

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34 35 Department means the Municipality of Anchorage Department of Health and Human Services.

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Notice and/or notification means a written announcement of pesticide or broadcast chemical spraying which includes specific information required in this chapter.

#### \*\*\* \*\*\* \*\*\*

Post and/or posting means affixing a notice to a structure, area, property or vegetation to be sprayed and maintaining such notice as specified in this chapter.

#### \*\*\* \*\*\* \*\*\*

Structure means that which is built or constructed, an edifice or building of any kind, or any piece of artificially built up or composed of parts joined together in some definite manner.

Section 2. Anchorage Municipal Code section 15.75.050 is hereby amended as follows:

## 15.75.050 Commercial application prohibited during certain wind conditions.

A person who engages in the business of applying pesticides or broadcast chemicals may not apply by spraying any pesticide or broadcast chemicals out of doors <u>in a manner that results in pesticide drift</u> or if the wind speed <u>at the site of application exceeds the maximum wind speed stated in the labeling</u>, or seven (7) miles per hour, [FIVE KNOTS] if no wind speed is stated in the labeling [AT THE SITE OF APPLICATION].

<u>Section 3.</u> Anchorage Municipal Code section 15.75.060 is hereby repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

# 15.75.060 Notice of application of pesticides or broadcast chemicals by a person engaged in the business of applying pesticides or broadcast chemicals.

- A. A person who engages in the business of applying pesticides or broadcast chemicals shall give written notice as provided by this chapter every time they plan to apply and/or have applied by spraying a pesticide or broadcast chemical out of doors. School use and notification shall be exempt from this chapter and shall meet all requirements of 18 AAC 90.625.
- B. Unless otherwise provided for in this section, a person engaged in the business of applying pesticides or broadcast chemicals shall provide notice not more than one hundred twenty (120) hours before application and at least forty-eight (48) hours before application, as specified in this section. Notice(s) shall be posted on a property to be treated at least forty-eight (48) hours before application and shall be constructed and situated so as to remain legible and in place for at least forty-eight (48) hours following pesticide or broadcast chemical spraying.
  - 1. Notice to multi-unit dwellings and/or multi-tenant commercial properties. Notwithstanding other provisions of this section, if the spraying service for a given property is procured by other than the tenant(s) or occupant(s) of a single family dwelling, notice as specified in this section shall be provided forty-eight (48) hours prior to spraying of pesticides(s) or broadcast chemical(s) to all tenants and occupants at the property. This includes non-owner occupied single family homes, multi-unit dwellings and commercial properties. The owner of the property shall retain the responsibility for providing notice to building tenants and/or occupants. A person engaged in the business of applying pesticide(s) and/or broadcast chemical(s) shall provide a copy of the notice(s) as required in this chapter to the property owner or manager in sufficient time to reasonably allow for

copying and distribution prior to the required forty-eight (48) hour notice period.

- 2. A person engaging in the business of applying pesticide(s) or broadcast chemical(s) shall distribute and post notices in a manner reasonably calculated to provide actual awareness of pesticide or broadcast chemical.
- 3. The notice shall include a large font header "Pesticide Application" and shall be at least 8 ½ inches by 11 inches in size. The notice shall include:
  - a. The trade name of each pesticide or broadcast chemical;
  - b. The active ingredient(s) in each pesticide or broadcast chemical;
  - c. The signal word, if one exists;
  - d. The exact date and approximate time the pesticide or broadcast chemical is planned to be or will be applied;
  - e. The area to be treated;
  - f. The rate, mode and concentration of application;
  - g. The manufacturer's recommended re-entry time;
  - h. The name, address, and telephone number of the permit holder, and shall indicate the permit holder is the person from whom copies of the Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) may be obtained;
  - i. A warning that the pesticide or broadcast chemical is or may be harmful;
  - j. A statement of recommended precautions; and
  - k. The statement, "If you have concerns, please contact your health care provider".

Legibility of posted notices shall be assured for at least forty-eight (48) hours after application of pesticide or broadcast chemical. The Department shall provide samples of notices and substantial compliance with notices shall constitute compliance with this chapter.

- 4. The required notices provided to residents and commercial establishments prior to spraying or application may be in the form of door-hangers, a mailing, or other methods conveying the same information as approved by the Department.
- C. Notice for spraying buildings or structures.
  - 1. If a pesticide or broadcast chemical is to be sprayed only on the exterior surface of a building or structure, and the linear distance to the nearest property line is ten (10) feet or greater, notice prior to spraying shall not be required. A notice shall be posted on the property where the pesticide is to

be applied immediately prior to spraying and shall remain in place for at least forty-eight (48) hours following spraying.

- 2. If a pesticide or broadcast chemical is to be sprayed only on the exterior surface of a building or structure, and the linear distance to the nearest property line is less than ten (10) feet, notice prior to the spraying is required for all properties within ten (10) feet of the area to be sprayed.
- D. Notice for spraying other than on buildings or structures.
  - 1. If a pesticide or broadcast chemical(s) is to be sprayed not more than six (6) feet above grade, and the linear distance to the nearest property line is ten (10) feet or greater, notice prior to spraying shall not be required. A notice shall be posted on the property where the pesticide is to be applied immediately prior to spraying and shall remain in place for at least forty-eight (48) hours following spraying.
  - 2. If a pesticide or broadcast chemical(s) is to be sprayed not more than six (6) feet above grade, and the linear distance to the nearest property line is less than ten (10) feet, notice prior to the spraying is required for all properties within ten (10) feet of the area to be sprayed. A notice shall be posted on the property where the pesticide is to be applied immediately prior to spraying and shall remain in place for at least forty-eight (48) hours following spraying.
  - 3. If a pesticide or broadcast chemical(s) is to be sprayed more than six (6) feet above grade, notice prior to the spraying is required for all properties within one hundred fifty (150) feet of the area to be sprayed.
- E. Notice need not be provided nor posted for:
  - 1. Use of single application aerosol cans against biting or stinging insects when applied according to label directions; or
  - 2. Antimicrobial pesticides used in commercial food establishments and drinking water wells; or
  - 3. Emergency situations as approved by the Department; or
  - 4. Application being made to a specific area on a property, and no property boundary is within one-hundred fifty (150) feet of the area.

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**Section 4.** Anchorage Municipal Code section 15.75.065 is hereby amended as follows:

# 15.75.065 Notice of pesticide and broadcast chemical application by municipality.

- A. The municipality shall <u>provide</u> [GIVE WRITTEN] notice in the manner <u>set forth</u> [DESCRIBED] <u>in section 15.75.060</u> and <u>as set forth</u> [DESCRIBED] in this section before it applies in any manner any pesticide or broadcast chemical out of doors.
- B [C]. The municipality shall post notices at areas treated as well as at main entrances of public parks that have been treated and at intervals not less than 100 feet along a [THE] perimeter of a sports playing field area to be treated if perimeter length exceeds 100 feet and in a manner which is reasonably calculated to provide actual awareness [NOTICE] of pesticide or broadcast chemical application.

[NOTICE MUST BE GIVEN AT LEAST 48 HOURS BEFORE APPLICATION AND NOT MORE THAN 96 HOURS BEFORE APPLICATION. POSTED NOTICES SHALL BE SITUATED AS TO REMAIN IN PLACE FOR AT LEAST 48 HOURS FOLLOWING PESTICIDE OR BROADCAST CHEMICAL APPLICATION.]

D. THE NOTICE SHALL INCLUDE A LARGE FONT HEADER "PESTICIDE APPLICATION" AND BE AT LEAST 8 ½ INCHES BY 11 INCHES. SHALL INCLUDE THE TRADENAME OF EACH PESTICIDE OR BROADCAST CHEMICAL; THE ACTIVE INGREDIENT(S) IN EACH PASTICDE OR BROADCAST CHEMICAL; THE SIGNAL WORD IF ONE EXISTSL THE EXACT DATE AND APPROXIMATE TIME THAT THE PESTICIDE OR BROADCAST CHEMICAL IS PLANNED TO BE OR WILL BE APPLIED; THE AREA TO BE TREATED' THE RATE, MODE AND CONCENTRATION OF APPLICATION: THE MANUFACTURER'S RECOMMENDED RE-ENTRY TIME; THE NAME, ADDRESS, AND TELEPHONE NUMBER OF THE PERMIT HOLDER THE NAME, ADDRESS AND TELEPHONE NUMBER OF THE PERSON FROM WHOM COPIES OF THE MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET (MSDS) MAY BE OBTAINED; A WARNING THAT THE PESTICIDE OR BROADCAST CHEMICAL IS OR MAY BEHARMFUL; A **STATEMENT** OF RECOMMENDED PRECAUTIONS; AND THE STATEMENT "IF YOU HAVE CONCERNS, PLEASE CONTACT YOUR HEALTH CARE PROVIDER". LEGIBILITY OF POSTED NOTICES SHALL BE ASSURED FOR AT LEAST 48 HOURS AFTER APPLICATION OF PESTICIDE OR BROADCAST CHEMICAL. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE SAMPLES OF SUCH NOTICES AND SUBSTANTIAL **COMPLIANCE** WITH SUCH **NOTICES** SHALL CONSTITUTE COMPLIANCE WITH THIS CHAPTER.]
