Subject: AO 2005-<u>58</u>; Dedication of Certain Municipal Lands for Park

or Recreational Purposes

In accordance with AO 2002-165, the Parks and Recreation Commission has considered and recommended the transfer of certain PLI land adjacent to Far North Bicentennial Park to mitigate the loss of natural open space park land to development of a ball field complex in the southwesterly portion of the park. The area is known as HLB Parcel No. 3-048, containing approximately 27.5 acres.

The land recommended for transfer contains upland area comparable in size and character to the above mentioned development area. In addition, the recommended transfer area includes wetland area adjacent to the South Fork of Campbell Creek. Protection of the riparian wetland area, as well as adjacent uplands, as park land is expected in turn to assure added protection of this important waterway.

As a consequence of the protected status of these lands as dedicated park land, the transfer of the lands is also expected to substantially meet certain regulatory mitigation requirements pursuant to development of the nearby Chuck Albrecht Sports Fields. Further documentation to that effect, such as conservation easement(s), consistent with the intent of AO 2002-165, may be appropriate.

The Parks and Recreation Commission, at its meeting March 13, 2003, recommended that this park area be transferred to park status.

The Administration concurs with this action and recommends approval of this ordinance formally dedicating the area as park land, as provided in AMC 25.10.080, to be known as part of Far North Bicentennial Park.
