AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 11.60.200 TO ADJUST MANDATORY AIRPORT FEES AND CHARGES.

WHEREAS, Increased expenses make it necessary to adjust mandatory airport fees and charges at Merrill Field; and,

WHEREAS, The Assembly shall establish all mandatory airport fees and charges imposed by the Municipality; and,

WHEREAS, It is intended that Merrill Field Airport be a self-sustaining facility and operate without support from the general fund; now, therefore

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Anchorage Municipal Code section 11.60.200 is amended to read as follows (the remainder of the section is not affected and therefore not set out):

### 11.60.200 Fees and charges.

- C. The following fees and charges shall be payable to the municipality at the office of the airport manager:
  - 1. Fee for distribution of aviation fuel. Every distributor of aviation fuel shall pay the municipality a fee of \$0.06 [\$0.05] for every gallon of aviation fuel that it delivers to a person at an airport. The distributor shall pay the fee monthly and attach a legible certified monthly summary [invoice copy] indicating the quantity of fuel delivered to each person during the past month. Deliveries to agencies of the United States government for the agency's use shall be exempt from this fee. Fuel transiting an airport as cargo is exempt from this fee.

These increases will allow the airport to continue to provide services at the current levels and to remain self-supporting. The Municipal Airports Aviation Advisory Commission supports the proposed rate increases.

SUBJECT: Review of the Merrill Field's Lease Terms

The Administration has completed an extensive review of Merrill Field's lease terms and has compiled a summary report with recommended revisions to the Merrill Field Lease Agreement. The proposed revisions would result in more benefits to the airport leaseholders and would make Merrill Field's leases more competitive with State airport leases.

The proposed revisions to the Merrill Field Lease Agreement were discussed at the May 5, 2005 Municipal Airports Aviation Advisory Commission (MAAAC) meeting. The MAAAC supports the proposed revisions to the Merrill Field Lease Agreement and also supports the proposed increases to the mandatory airport fees and charges.

The Administration recommends the following revisions to the Merrill Field Lease Agreement;

# 1) Rental Rates and Future Rent Increases:

- Continue utilizing a cost approach as a method of establishing uniform land rental rates for airport properties.
- Provide for limits on the rent adjustments that may take place during the first year or several years of a lease, depending on the length of the lease.
- Approve an amended version of AO 2004-153 which would include an additional increase to the aircraft parking fees (from \$2/mo increase to \$5/mo increase). The increased aircraft parking fees would provide the revenue needed to meet increased expenses and offset the need to increase lease rates for the current budget year.

# 2) Determination of Length of Lease or Lease Extension:

 Determine the length of a lease or lease extension based on the amount of investment expended by the tenant and other factors in addition thereto including the purchase price paid for the permanent improvements and the fair market value and/or remaining useful life of the permanent improvements.

# 3) Disposition of Improvements at Lease Termination:

 Provide that all improvements placed by the tenant on the leased premises during the term of the lease belong to the tenant at the termination of the lease and allow the tenant to sell the improvements to a succeeding lessee and provide that the Municipality may require the tenant to remove the improvements only if the improvements do not comply with written airport operational policies or are not in MOA's best interest, the improvements are not sold, MOA makes written findings that the improvements are a hazard to public health and safety or constitute a nuisance, the improvements have existing building code violations, or the improvements create landfill gas concerns or interfere with the operation of the landfill gas extraction system.

Future Assembly actions will be required to implement the recommended revisions to the Merrill Field Lease Agreement.

The Assembly requested this summary for their consideration prior to taking action on Ordinance AO 2004-153, a proposed ordinance amending AMC 11.60.200 to increase the mandatory airport fees and charges (AO 2004-153 was postponed indefinitely on January 18. 2005). The Administration has submitted a new Ordinance which increases Merrill Field's Municipal aircraft tiedown fees. As discussed at previous Assembly work sessions, the increase will make Merrill Field's Municipal tiedown fees more in balance with Merrill Field Leaseholder's tiedown fees and the State of Alaska Lake Hood's tiedown fees.
