PUBLIC SECTOR ECONOMIC EFFECTS:

Lowering the regulated vehicle minimum liability insurance requirements does not expose the Municipality of Anchorage, which is not liable for regulated vehicle-related injuries to persons or property. Thus, no impact upon the public sector is anticipated.

PRIVATE SECTOR ECONOMIC EFFECTS:

The current regulated vehicle liability insurance minimums established in Anchorage are the highest requirements in the nation. A reduction in insurance minimums is anticipated to reduce insurance premium rates. Additionally, more insurance carriers are expected to enter the Anchorage market, with the possibility of competition resulting in further premium reductions. The reduction of liability insurance minimums will lower the regulated vehicle industry's insurance costs while maintaining a reasonable measure of protection to the regulated vehicle occupants.

LIABILITY INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS.

The purpose of this memorandum is to request Assembly approval of a revision to Anchorage Municipal Code section 11.20.100, reducing the minimum liability insurance requirements for regulated vehicles (taxicabs, limousines, and vehicles for hire). Lowering the minimum insurance requirements does not expose the Municipality of Anchorage, which is not liable for regulated vehicle-related injuries to persons or property.

The current minimum insurance requirements in Anchorage are the highest requirements in the nation. The situation is particularly problematic for taxicab owners since only one insurance carrier is willing to write coverage for Anchorage taxicabs. In the absence of competition, the insurance carrier's premium rates skyrocketed and its strict restrictions regarding taxicab drivers eliminated may drivers from working. The expectation is reduction of minimum insurance requirements will correspondingly reduce the premium rates and may lead to further rate reductions through competition among insurance carriers willing to enter the market if requirements are reduced.

There is no evidence of claims against insurers to justify retaining the existing minimum requirements. In all other cities for which information has been obtained, the balance between industry cost and customer coverage resulted in minimum insurance requirements less than the current Anchorage requirements. The intent of the minimum insurance requirement is not to cover all possible claims but rather to supply a reasonable measure of protection to the regulated vehicle occupants.

THE ADMINISTRATION RECOMMENDS APPROVAL OF AN ORDINANCE REDUCING THE MINIMUM LIABILITY INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR REGULATED VEHICLES SET OUT IN ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 11.20.100.
