

AO 2005-136 - Naming of Municipal Buildings, Other Fixed Facilities and

Public Places.

The procedures set out in AMC 9.97.030 for naming municipal buildings and facilities were enacted in 1987 and have not been amended subsequently. That section currently authorizes the mayor to name a five-member citizen panel to review or identify appropriate names. These citizens may be chosen from any part of the city and may be members of recognized boards or commissions, but that choice is optional and at the discretion of the mayor. There is no provision to include input from the community or neighborhood that is affected or the elected representative of that district.

As set forth in AMC 2.40.020, the purpose of the community councils is to "to provide a direct and continuing means of citizen participation in government and local affairs." Enactment of AO 2005–136 will ensure that buildings and facilities are named with the participation of neighborhood representatives as well as their elected assembly member.
