

ANCHORAGE, ALASKA No. AO 2005-138(S)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE BY REPEALING CHAPTER 2.80, PERTAINING TO THE ASSEMBLY BUDGET AND LEGISLATIVE SERVICES OFFICE, AND ENACTING A NEW SECTION 2.20.055, PERTAINING TO THE MUNICIPAL CLERK'S OFFICE.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. In order to more efficiently and effectively manage the business of the Anchorage Municipal Assembly, and to avoid waste and duplication of effort, Anchorage Municipal Code chapter 2.80 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

<u>Section 2.</u> Anchorage Municipal Code chapter 2.20 is amended to add a new section 2.20.055 (reenacting certain provisions from chapter 2.80, amending some of those provisions and adding certain additional provisions) as follows:

2.20.055 Municipal Clerk's Office.

A. <u>Organization.</u>

1. The Municipal Clerk's office is established by Charter Sections 4.05 and 4.06. The Municipal Clerk's office shall consist of the following divisions, with the duties and responsibilities as set out hereinafter, in the Charter, and elsewhere in the Anchorage Municipal Code, or as may be established by the Presiding Officer of the Assembly:

a. *Municipal Clerk*. The duties of the Municipal Clerk are set out in section 2.20.050.

b. Deputy Clerk: Boards, Licensing & Administration. The general duties shall consist of agenda control, document control, minutes, licensing and administration.

c. Deputy Clerk: Elections and Budget. The general duties shall consist of conducting municipal elections, assisting in municipal and utility budget review.

B. Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. To provide administrative and logistical support to the Assembly and to its individual Members, the Municipal Clerk shall assign the duties and responsibilities set forth below, as appropriate, in consultation with the Presiding Officer, to staff members within the four (4) divisions described above to best accomplish the tasks assigned.
- 2. The duties and responsibilities of the four (4) divisions are generally described as follows, but shall, in addition, consist of those additional duties and responsibilities as may be assigned by the Presiding Officer or as are set forth in other sections of the Code.
 - a. To prepare ordinances, resolutions, memoranda and other working papers to support of the activities of the Assembly and its individual Members equally without discrimination among the Members; and
 - b. To work with the Presiding Officer in scheduling Assembly meetings, work sessions and committee meetings; and
 - c. To attend Assembly meetings, Assembly work sessions and standing and ad hoc committee meetings as required by the Presiding Officer, and to maintain such records of such proceedings as required by ordinance or as required by the Presiding Officer; and
 - d. To work with the Presiding Officer in reviewing and scheduling Assembly agenda items to determine compliance with the requirements of the Charter, the Code, and the adopted policies and procedures of the Assembly and, further, to insure the Assembly timely and appropriately deals with those matters coming before the Assembly; and
 - e. To assist the Assembly in its analysis of the operating, capital and utility budgets prepared and presented by the Administration, as may be directed by the Presiding Officer; and
 - f. To administer the contract for the annual Municipal Independent Financial Audit and such other contracts as may be assigned by ordinance; and

1 3	D.	<u>Political activities by staff.</u> It is imperative the staff of <u>all divisions of</u> the				
15	<i></i>	Municipal Clerk's office serve all of the citizens of the Municipality in a				
16		fair equal and nonpartisan manner. Therefore the staff of all divisions of				

the Municipal Clerk's office, including the Municipal Clerk, shall not engage in partisan politics in any manner, as further described as follows:

- 1. The staff shall not participate in any capacity, whether paid or unpaid, nor make any political contributions of any nature, cash or in kind, in any municipal election campaign including elections for Mayor, for members of the Assembly, for members of the School Board, or for any office on any Service Area Board or Commission in which the staff person does not personally reside. Staff shall not participate in any local ballot initiative, bond proposal, proposed charter amendment or other matter put before the voters of the Municipality or any service area of the Municipality.
- 2. Nothing set forth above shall prohibit staff from expressing private political opinions, so long as such expression does not interfere in any manner with or occur during the business operation of the Municipal Clerk's office.

E. *Annual Budget and Administrative Procedure.*

- 1. The Municipal Clerk's office shall annually prepare a budget proposal for submission to the Assembly. Copies shall be provided in a timely manner to the mayor for informational purposes to assist in the preparation of the municipal budget.
- 2. The Municipal Clerk's office shall comply with those administrative procedures prescribed by ordinance except as otherwise provided in this section. Requests for approval of various administrative matters shall be submitted to the Administration in proper form. In order to ensure the independence and objectivity of the Municipal Clerk's office, the Administration's discretionary administrative decisions shall be considered advisory.
- 3. The Administration shall retain the authority to deny any request contrary to ordinance or exceeding the assembly-adopted budget.
- 4. Any disputes arising between the Administration and the Municipal Clerk regarding administrative matters shall be resolved by the Presiding Officer and the Mayor.
