

A key goal of this administration is to bolster quality of life for municipal residents. The administration proposes to elevate the Community Development Division from division to department status:

New: Department of Neighborhoods

Elevating the Community Development Division (CDD) to department status recognizes the importance of neighborhoods to our community, and facilitates the work and efficiency of this grant-funded area. The Department of Neighborhoods, along with the Housing and Neighborhood Development (HAND) Commission, will improve responsiveness to residents by creating synergies between multiple housing and community development grant programs that impact neighborhoods, and will facilitate this Department's pursuit of additional grant resources for neighborhood improvements. The Community Development Division has always managed the federally funded Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME), totaling just over \$3,000,000 in federal grant funds annually. During 2005, CDD expanded to incorporate the Weatherization Program (with just over \$1,000,000 annual budget) and the Mountain View Revitalization Loan Fund (with a total of \$7,000,000). Over the past year, CDD also successfully pursued several other smaller housing and neighborhood development funding resources. There are no increased costs associated with this changed, and the Summary of Economic Effects form is included as **Exhibit B**.

The benefits of the reorganization are:

 Optimization of the expertise needed for housing and neighborhood development grant administration and programs, including construction, rehabilitation, neighborhood planning, grant administration, procurement and reporting to funders and the community.

• Coordination of resources to work with the community to design programs responsive to neighborhood needs, especially in the area of neighborhood improvements.
