1 A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE ADOPTING THE ANCHORAGE
2 ALL-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN.
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5 WHEREAS, Anchorage is vulnerable to a variety of natural and man-caused
6 hazards that have in the past and can in the future affect public safety, damage or destroy public
7 and private property, disrupt the local economy, and impact the quality of life; and

9 WHEREAS, The Municipality of Anchorage recognizes the economic and societal
10 benefits of developing a community all-hazard mitigation plan with strategies to avoid or reduce
11 damage and disruption resulting from natural and man-caused disasters; and
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13 WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency may grant hazard
14 mitigation funding to Anchorage during a Federal-declared disaster; and
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16 WHEREAS, federal law requires the Municipality of Anchorage to have an
17 approved all-hazard mitigation plan in order to receive hazard mitigation grant funds associated
18 with a federally-declared disaster; and
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20 WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage, with community input, has prepared
21 the Anchorage All-Hazard Mitigation Plan; and
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
23 WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency has reviewed and
24 approved the Plan subject to adoption by the Municipality of Anchorage; NOW THEREFORE,
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26 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:
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
28 **Section 1.** That the Anchorage All-Hazard Mitigation Plan approved by the Federal
